NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS CALLING FOR BIDS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the **San Diego Community College District** of San Diego County, California, acting by and through its Governing Board, hereinafter referred to as the DISTRICT, will receive up to, but not later than **2:00 pm** of the **24th** day of **September, 2010**, sealed bids for the award of a contract for:

BUILDINGS F-100 / F-200 / J-200 / SITE DEMOLITION AND GRADING PROJECT
AT MESA COLLEGE, SAN DIEGO

Bids shall be received in the office of the Owner in Suite 310 at the SAN DIEGO COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT, 3375 Camino del Rio, South, San Diego, California, 92108 and shall be opened and publicly read aloud at the above-stated time and place.

Each bid must conform and be responsive to the contract documents, copies of which are now on file and may be purchased **on August 30, 2010**, at C2 Reprographics, 4920 Carroll Canyon Road, San Diego, CA 92121. Telephone – 858.535.0607, Fax – 858.535.0671. Notification of subsequent Addendums, if required, will addressed via Bid Mail. Reference Project #12110-N-5 when ordering documents or electronic data.

A **Mandatory Pre-Bid Walk** will be held on **September 9, 2010 at 8 a.m.** Meet outside the circular main entrance of the Library-LRC Building, 7250 Mesa College Drive, San Diego, CA 92111. **This site visit is mandatory and should a bidder not attend, they will not be allowed to bid as it is a material requirement of the contract.**

The final date for the submission of Requests For Information to the Design Team is **September 13, 2010.**

As a condition of bidding and in accordance with the provisions of Section 20651.5 of the California Public Code and Section 20101 of the California Local Agency Public Construction Act, the District is requiring prequalification of all contractors wishing to submit bids over the amount of \$500,000 on the project. Bids will not be accepted if a contractor has not been prequalified and his bidding amount is over the threshold of \$500,000.

Each bid shall be accompanied by the security referred to in the contract documents, the non-collusion affidavit, the list of proposed subcontractors, and all additional documentation required by the Instructions to Bidders.

In contracts involving an expenditure in excess of \$ 25,000.00, the successful bidder shall file a payment bond issued by an admitted Surety approved to conduct business in the State of California approved by the District in the form set forth in the contract documents.*

The District reserves the right to reject any or all bids or to waive any irregularities or informalities in any bids or in the bidding.

*A payment bond must be filed for a contract involving an expenditure in excess of \$25,000 (Civil Code section 3247(a)) and may be required for contracts involving smaller expenditures at the option of the Owner.

The lowest responsive bid will be determined solely on the lowest base contract bid. Even if alternate bids are sought by the District, the lowest responsive bid will be based solely on the lowest base contract bid.

The Director of Industrial Relations has determined the general prevailing rate of per diem wages in the locality in which this work is to be performed for each craft or type of worker needed to execute the contract which will be awarded to the successful bidder, copies are at the following website: www.dir.ca.gov.

It shall be mandatory upon the Contractor to whom the contract is awarded, and upon any subcontractor under him, to pay not less than the said specified rates to all workers employed by them in the execution of the contract.

Labor Compliance Program: The Contractor and every subcontractor that is listed in the bid documents shall be required to comply with the District's Labor Compliance Program.

Each bidder at a minimum, shall be a licensed Contractor pursuant to the Business and Professions Code and shall be licensed in the following classification: **B**

Each listed and unlisted lower tier subcontractor(s), if any, shall possess a State of California Contractors State License that is current, active and in good standing for the scope of work that will be contracted.

No bidder may withdraw his bid for a period of **NINETY (90)** days after the date set for the opening of bids.
